

# Before you start

Familiarize yourself with these instructions. The Cargo Basket is shipped in one parcel. Ensure that all listed parts and hardware are present in the package. Gather the required tools.



# Installation:

Before you start to work, familiarize with the **Cargo Basket Diagram** on **page 8**. There is an exploded view that shows you how to mount the basket parts together.

The example is shown for the **right basket**, the left basket is a **mirror look** so the installation scheme is similar.

Follow the steps below to install product correctly:

- 1. Start by preparing the product parts and gathering the necessary tools.
- Pre-screw back part, bottom part, side parts and front panel together using M4x10 flange bolts and M4 flange nuts. The nuts should be screwed on the inside of the basket.
- 3. Adjust the basket parts if necessary and tighten all the bolts and nuts.
- 4. Pre-screw the **mounting brackets** to the basket using **M6x12 carriage bolt** and **M6 flange nut**.

Now you are ready to install the basket inside the car.

5. You need to unscrew **two plastic holders** (see picture below) inside the trunk. Use a **10 mm socket** or **Phillips screwdriver**.



- 6. Place the basket on the left/right side of the car and screw the upper brackets, in the place of previously removed plastic holders, using M6x20 flange bolts.
- 7. Adjust the **position**, push down the basket and tighten the **bolts and nuts**.

#### 8. (OPTIONAL but RECOMMENDED)

The installation kit contains additional 2 Phillips screws. In the bottom of the basket are **2 small holes** and **2 bigger holes**. Screw the basket to the plastic car body through the small holes using **Phillips screws**.

Make sure that everything is mounted properly, and all the bolts are tightened. If it everything is correct, your work is done.
