




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Before you start







The installation requires the **Bison Gear Roof Shelf** to be installed first. Familiarize yourself with these instructions. The Cargo Barrier is shipped in one parcel. Ensure that all listed parts and hardware are present in the package.

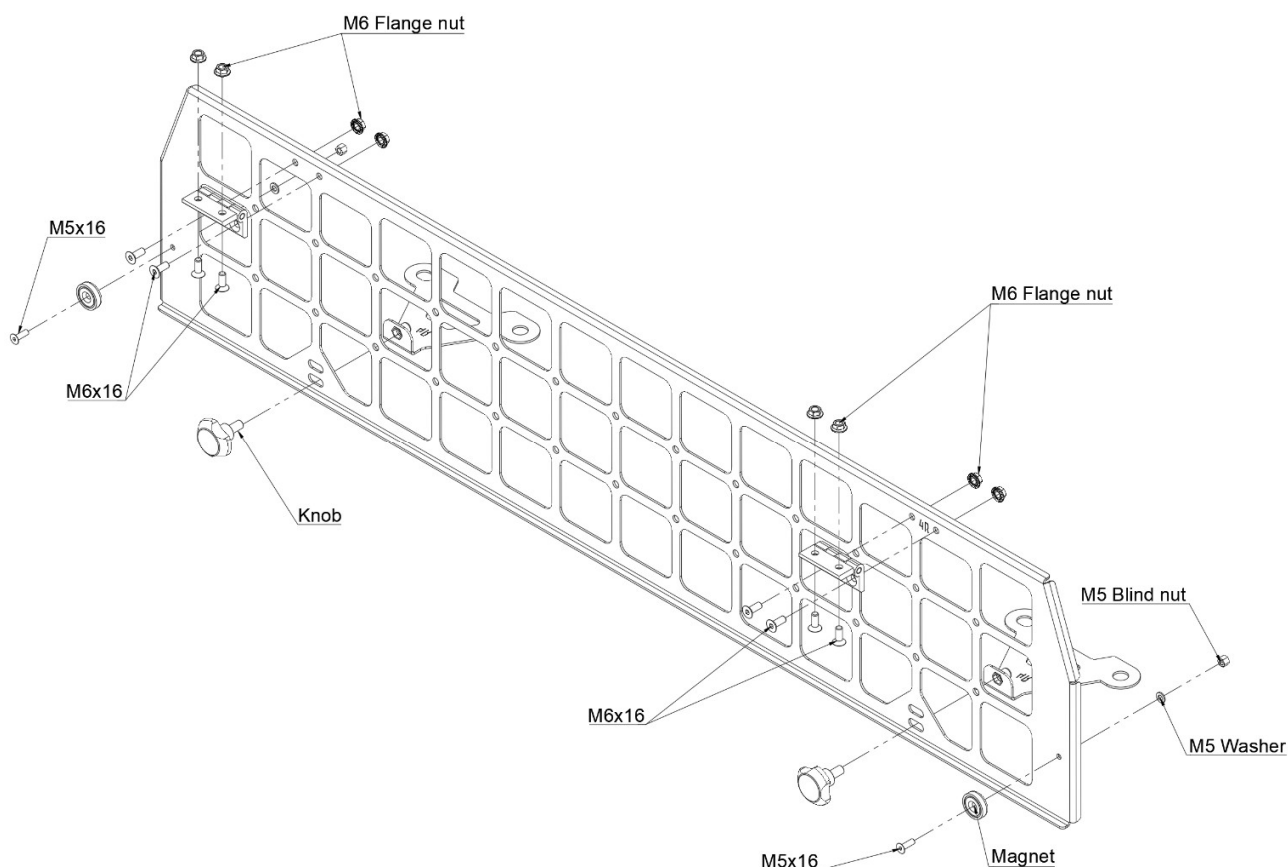

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Installation:

Before you start to work, familiarize yourself with the **Cargo Barrier Diagram** on **page 4**. Follow the steps below to install the cargo barrier correctly:

1. Install the **magnets** using **M5x16 screws** and **M5 blind nuts**. (Sometimes the magnets are already screwed to the cargo barrier, and you do not have to do it).
2. Pre-screw the **hinges** to the barrier using **M6x16 bolts** and **M6 nuts**.
3. Remove the **second-row headrests** and put the **headrest brackets** on them (put the rods into the bracket's holes) and reinstall it.

In the next step you will need assistance of **one other person** who will hold the cargo barrier during the mounting process.

4. Put the **cargo barrier** inside the car and screw it to the Bison Gear's Roof Shelf using **M6x16 screws** and **flange nuts** (you have a choice of 3 possible mounting points – 3 sets of oblong holes)
5. Screw the **knobs** into the **headrest bracket** (there are 2 oblong holes, choose the ones giving you the best fitment).
6. Regulate the vertical and horizontal position of the shelf and screw **all the bolts**.

Make sure that everything is mounted properly, and all the bolts are tightened. If everything is correct, your work is done.

After driving 50km, check all the bolts and re-tighten them if necessary.
